Job Summary

Kit Production Technician reporting to the Head of Dispatch. You will be responsible for supporting and participating in the production/assembly of all in-house Finished Goods products. This role is on a temporary basis for approximately 8 weeks.

Main duties and responsibilities

- Work within a team under general guidance from Head of Dispatch or Dispatch Supervisor to produce
 Finished Goods enabling continuous supply in accordance with the relevant production schedule.
 Includes labelling, assembly, packaging and dispatch of RUO and diagnostic kits. Ensure training records
 are kept up to date.
- Assist with the on-time dispatch of packaged finished goods.
- Ensure strict adherence to all relevant work instructions, Quality procedures, H&S policies and GMP. Fully and accurately complete all production documentation.
- Assist with the completion of production support activities in a timely manner to enable production.
- Where required provide training to new staff in production.
- Assist in ensuring all production areas are kept in full working order, are safe, are organised, are clean and are adequately stocked with consumables.
- Actively initiate, support and participate in Quality, HS&E or process related continuous improvement initiatives.
- Any other reasonable tasks required by Head of Dispatch.

- Experience of working within an assembly environment.
- An awareness of Quality System requirements including GMP.
- Excellent attention to detail.
- Good communication skills.
- An optimistic and helpful attitude with a desire to getting tasks completed to schedule essential.
