Job Summary

The role of the Head of Planning is to provide the communication link between the business demand: Sales, Marketing and New Product introduction and the supply chain capacity: internal production and subcontractors. Provide overall leadership and direction to the business planning teams to generate a coherent and integrated plan for the manufacturing facilities, both external sub-contract manufacturers and laboratory production. Help set direction for business capacity requirement, pre-empt problems and provide recommendations to the senior team.

Main duties and responsibilities

- 1. Overall responsibility for;
 - a. the availability of stock ensuring on-time-in-full metric is kept at industry leading levels and stock turn is maximised
 - b. the generation of a demand plan for all products. Liaise with sales, marketing, new product development and senior team to ensure there is a realistic demand plan for each product
 - c. producing a manufacturing schedule consistent with the prioritised needs of the business
 - d. providing a procurement plan identifying and minimising material shortages and lead time limitations
 - e. the accuracy of masterdata for all components, subassemblies and finished goods inc. BOM accuracy and warehouse information across the business
 - f. leading the implementation and continuous development of MRP functionality across the business
- 2. Prepare the Sales and Operational plan, make recommendations to the senior team on how to close gaps between demand and capacity to optimise the supply chain and meet customer requirements
- 3. Produce an integrated manufacturing plan for each sub-contract manufacturer and weekly manufacturing priorities for each site
- 4. Challenge constraints in the supply chain plan for local manufacturing and sub-contract manufacturing
- 5. Liaise with New Product Development to incorporate launch timeframe, quantities, and probability into the demand plan

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- 6. Smooth the demand through production to achieve efficiencies and maximise the effectiveness of available resources
- 7. Understand the medium-term storage requirements for Raw Materials, Work in Progress and Finished Product, make recommendations to optimise
- 8. Track and report supply chain performance metrics to the business
- 9. Anticipate supply chain problems and implement preventative actions
- 10. Provide leadership to the planning department; coach, support and motivate the team
- 11. Share best practice across Novacyt subsidiary companies Primer Design, Microgen, Lab21 and IT IS
